1	<p>The tender documentation states that the supplier should include 3 references of significant deliveries in the last 3 years prior to the start of the procurement period.</p> <p>How will this period of 3 years be counted? For example, a supplier has a significant delivery which he uses as a reference which started in January 2017 however this is a 5-year contract which is therefore still active. Is this then ok?</p> <p>Do al significant deliveries need to be 100% delivered or is it ok if some stages of the project are delivered and others are still ongoing and planned?</p>	<p>Explained.</p> <p>The evidence of technical qualification of the supplier may include reference of significant delivery in progress.</p> <p>This is enabled by the contracting authority's required structure of the list of significant deliveries to be included in the suppliers' tender.</p> <p>Please refer to the paragraph 5.5. of the tender documentation.</p>
