1	<p>Technical Specification - Parameter B1: requires recognition and classification of the vehicle according to the manufacturer, make and type of vehicle.</p> <p>How should the supplier understand the difference between the manufacturer and the vehicle brand?</p>	<p>Explained, tender documentation amended.</p> <p>The contracting authority hereby explains the conditions for a possible offer of the participant concerning the additional parameter defined in paragraph 3.1 of Annex No. 1 of the tender documentation. Parameter B1 newly reads as follows: <i>recognition and classification of the vehicle according to the make and model of the vehicle in the sense of Section 13 (3) a) and b) of Decree 343/2014 Coll., on vehicle registration. For example, Ford (make) Focus (model) or Renault (make) Thalia (model).</i></p>
2	<p>If the supplier offers optional additional parameters that will also be tested and for some reason will not pass the functional test. Will the subsequent overall evaluation of the key functional parameters be evaluated separately, or will it exclude the tender according to point 10.9 of the tender documentation? Or does the vendor not receive points for additional features?</p> <p>Example: The supplier will offer car color recognition as an additional function and consequently will not meet the correct color detection and will be below the 80% limit. Will such a supplier be excluded from the tender or will he just not receive additional points?</p>	<p>Explained.</p> <p>The procedure in case of unsuccessful testing of samples is described in paragraphs 16.17 and 16.18 of the tender documentation. The example given by the participant is considered by the contracting authority to be a non-fulfillment of the condition of Section 104 b) for the conclusion of a contract with the selected supplier. Therefore, the contracting authority will not be able to conclude a contract with the selected supplier and will exclude it from the procurement procedure.</p>
3	<p>Point 16.6 of the tender documentation states: "The selected supplier shall, in agreement with the contracting authority, within 2 weeks of the call</p>	<p>Explained.</p> <p>The contracting authority will not extend the</p>

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	<p>pursuant to paragraph 16.4 deliver the same number and types of camera systems that he proposed to install on the selected toll gate in accordance with paragraph 8.2 of this tender documentation."</p> <p>In what month does the contracting authority plan to perform the test? Due to the current situation associated with the disease Covid-19, without careful planning in such a short period of time, the delivery of camera systems to the client is difficult to implement, mainly due to long delivery times of equipment from abroad. Given the current global situation, does the contracting authority not intend to reconsider its request and extend the deadline?</p>	<p>period of 2 weeks from the call, as it considers it sufficient for the delivery of goods for one toll gate</p> <p>The contracting authority cannot set a specific date for the testing of samples, as it depends not only on its will but also on the complexity of the assessment and evaluation of the tenders received, the legal deadlines and the overall course of the procurement procedure. In any case, the contracting authority is interested in terminating the procurement procedure as soon as possible.</p> <p>For the sake of completeness, the contracting authority adds that the requirement stated in paragraph 16.6 of the tender documentation has been specified in connection with other explanations of the tender documentation.</p>

In view of the above content of the explanation, the contracting authority modified the content of the following documents of the tender documentation: the main document of the tender documentation, including Annexes No. 1, 2, 4 and 5.

New versions of these documents were published by the contracting authority together with this explanation.

In connection with changes in the tender documentation, including the previous ones, and the delayed publication of certain explanations of the tender documentation, the contracting authority extends the deadline for submission of tenders until 25 May 2020 until 12:00 (noon).
